

How to adjust the length of your pant legs....

****The fabrics we use on our pants do not require a hem, so no sewing is required.**

- Put costume on and make sure the waist and crotch are in the right area.
- Stand up straight and look straight ahead, have someone else mark the bottom of the pants where they hit the floor behind the heel of the foot.
- Remove the costume and fold the pants so the legs lay on top of each other and are flat.
- At the mark, cut straight across the leg to the other side thru both legs.
- For best results and a clean straight cut, use a rotary cutter and a metal ruler.

Straps, Belts, and/or Ties

If your garment contains straps, belts, and/or ties that are unattached, this is intentional to allow a customized fit to each performer. It is recommended that you do the following:

Shoulder Strap

- Put costume on and have someone else place the strap in the appropriate position.
- Attach the strap to the garment with a safety pin.
- The strap can stay attached with a safety pin or be hand sewn into the garment.

Belts and Arm/Leg Ties

- Put on the costume. Tie the belt in the desired way.
- Ensure uniformity of length between performers prior to cutting.
- Cut any excess using sharp scissors.
- Sewing, fray check, or burning is not required.



DAMAGE, COSTUME DISCREPANCY OR SIZING CONCERNS

Upon receipt of your costumes, please open boxes immediately and fit performers as soon as possible. If you find any discrepancies to the costume you received you must let us know within 7 days of receiving the costumes. Once we have received this information, we will access and determine the next step.

WASHING & CARE INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL COSTUMES

*******Please make copies of instructions for all members!*******

1. **HAND WASH** in a large volume of **cold** water
2. **Use** a small amount of mild liquid detergent; **Do Not** use "Woolite" or similar soaps
3. **Do Not** use fabric softeners
4. **Rinse** costume immediately
5. **Do Not** soak or leave costume in a wet pile
6. **Use** a thick plastic hanger to air dry
7. **Do Not** dry clean
8. **Do Not** dry in dryer
9. **Do Not** iron
10. Alcohol in all aerosol products affects the fabrics. **Always cover your costume when using hair spray or perfume**
11. Deodorants and perspiration may cause the fabric to fade. We recommend the use of pure crystal deodorant. **Do not** use Arm & Hammer or baking soda deodorant
